2017-2018 Reproductive Assessment Collection Charters

Please refer to the **2017-18 Reproductive Assessment Collection Charter Bid Specifications** for detailed charter requirements information.

The IPHC will consider bids based upon a monthly lump sum (not a daily rate) for the completion of each month's sampling regardless of the number of days required to complete the work. The IPHC will pay monthly lump sums after the collection activity for the previous month is complete.

Unless combined with quota fishing, all retained fish become property of the IPHC. If charter is combined with quota fishing, the vessel will retain ownership of any retained fish.

The bid evaluation process usually takes two to three weeks after the closing date. If you are new to IPHC charters (or haven't worked with us in recent years), please let us know as soon as possible of your intention to bid, so that we can schedule an inspection of your vessel. This will expedite the process.

Completed bids must be mailed, couriered, emailed (.pdf) or faxed in time to arrive in the IPHC's Seattle office **by 12:00 noon (Pacific Daylight Time) on Monday, 12 June, 2017**. We have encountered problems in the past with bids posted too late to arrive in Seattle by the deadline (**postmarked dates do not apply to the deadline date**). If mailing, please allow sufficient time for it to arrive. Be sure to mark all bids (whether mailed, emailed or faxed) with: "**CHARTER BID: Attn: Josep Planas**".
