**1. What is the definition and objective of the proposal?**  
 Daily Limit for guided anglers in 3A is 1 fish over 30 inches, or 2 fish 30 inches & under.

**2a. Who might benefit from the proposed change?**

Guided anglers, & charter boat operators, Benefit, most anglers are happy with one fish if it a larger fish. Anglers are not happy with one minnow, but are ok when catching smaller fish if the limit is 2. Charter operators benefit financially with this rule compared to an additional day off in peak season & anglers benefit from an increased seasonal limit, & more opportunity with 6 days a week available to fish compared to 5 days.

Nobody suffers, & this method of harvest reduction will save more fish, & more pounds without the financial hardship of additional days off each week
