## Mr. Adam Keizer Biography

As the Groundfish Regional Manager with Fisheries and Oceans Canada, **Mr. Adam Keizer** is responsible for the management of Pacific halibut, multi-species bottom trawl, hake, sablefish, rockfish, lingcod, and dogfish fisheries in the Pacific Region. In this role Mr. Keizer leads the implementation of a management regime that coordinates fisheries assessment, monitoring, and enforcement efforts in collaboration with a diversity of Indigenous, commercial, recreational, governmental, and non-governmental parties.

Mr. Keizer joined Fisheries and Oceans Canada in 2007 as a fishery manager before becoming the Groundfish Regional Manager in 2017. In this capacity he also served as an advisor to Canadian Commissioners at the IPHC, and has served as co-chair of the Management Strategy Advisory Board since May 2015.

Mr. Keizer holds a Bachelor of Science in Environmental Science and a Master of Resource Management in Fisheries Science and Management from Simon Fraser University.
