**Dr. Kim Scribner** is an evolutionary ecologist and a Professor of Fisheries and Wildlife at Michigan State University, with a co-appointment in Zoology. He is one of several faculty in the Department of Fisheries and Wildlife who holds a cooperative appointment through the Partnership for Ecosystem Research and Management (PERM) program with regional Fisheries and Wildlife agencies. His appointment is affiliated with the Fisheries Division of the Michigan Department of Natural Resources. He is also active in several inter-disciplinary and inter-departmental graduate programs at MSU, including the Ecology, Evolutionary Biology and Behavior Program and the Genetic Program.

Dr. Scribner has broad interests in population genetics and vertebrate life history, demography and behavior. Research in his lab involves novel application of molecular genetic markers and evolutionary theory to examine important questions in ecological genetics and conservation biology.
